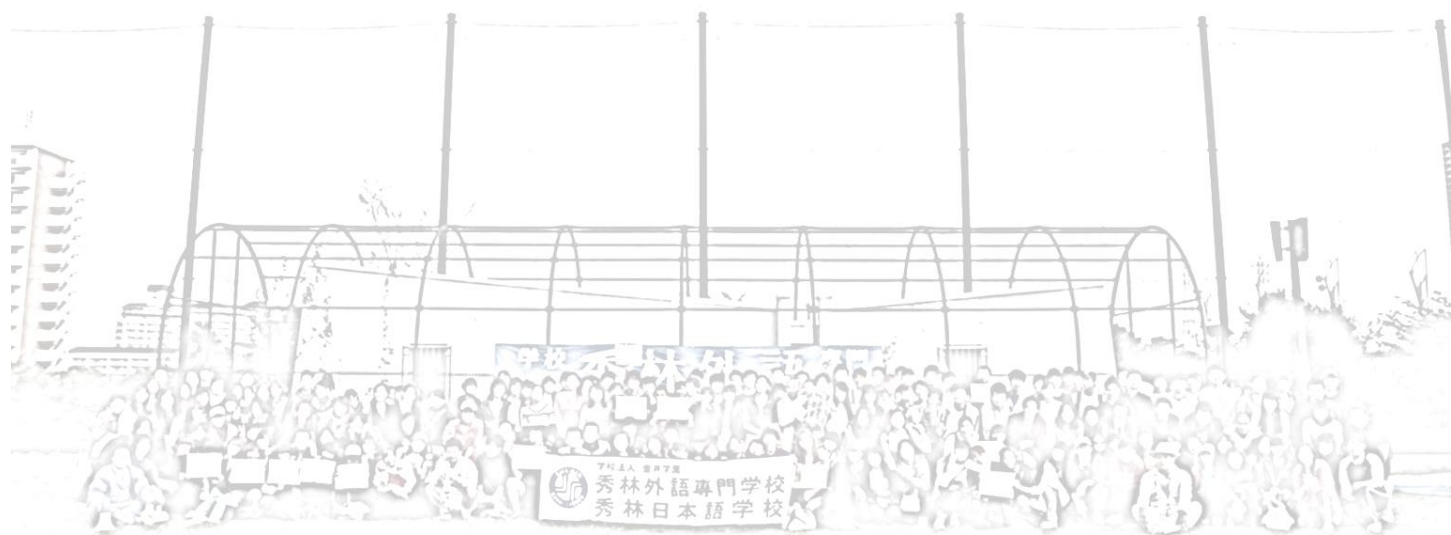


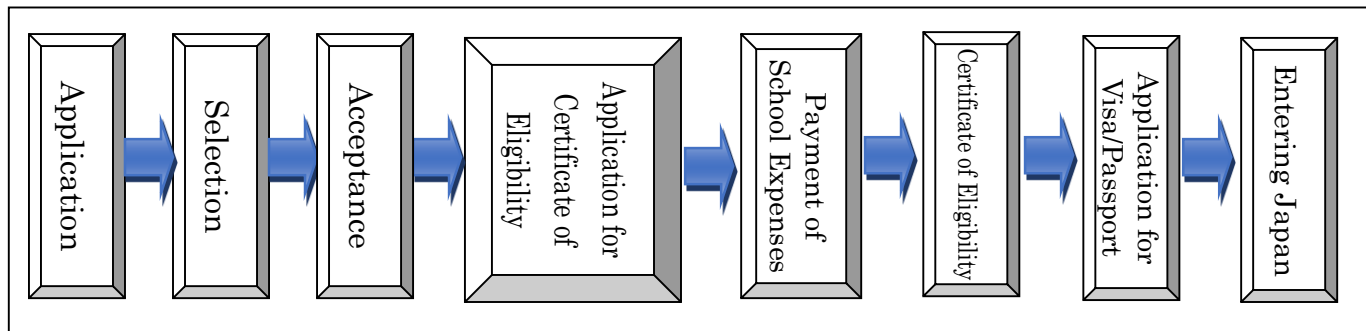

▼ Necessary Documents (Documents ① to ⑨ are compulsory)

- ① Application Form
- ② Selection Fee (JPY25,000-)
- ③ 5 Photos (4cm×3cm)
- ④ Personal Record (3 pages)
- ⑤ Graduation Certificate (High School/University)
- ⑥ Academic transcript (High School/University)
- ⑦ Certificate of Japanese Study (JLPT, J-test, NAT-test, etc.)
- ⑧ Photocopy of the front page of the passport (if applicable)
- ⑨ Birth Certificate

Please put Japanese translations on the all documents written excluding Japanese.

【If the guarantor outside Japan pays the school and life expenses】

- ⑩ Pledge and Explanation Circumstances Leading to Sponsor's Decision to Pay Expenses for Student
- ⑪ Official document that proves the relationship between the guarantor and the student
- ⑫ Certificate of the balance of the guarantor's bank account
- ⑬ Guarantor's job certificate and the proof of her/his annual income
- ⑭ Copy of bank book of name of the financial sponsor (3 years)

【If a guarantor in Japan pays school and life expenses】

- ⑩ Pledge and Explanation Circumstances Leading to Sponsor's Decision to Pay Expenses for Student
- ⑪ Certificate of the balance of the guarantor's bank account
- ⑫ Guarantor's job certificate
- ⑬ Guarantor's tax payment certificate
- ⑭ Official resident card
- ⑮ Copy of bank book of name of the financial sponsor (3 years)

▼Others

Certificate of Admission and other procedures	<p>The applicant or his respective agent is required to transfer school expenses (Admission Fee, Tuition Fee, Facility Maintenance Fee and Student Activity Fee) in full into school's bank account once the applicant's Certificate of Eligibility is issued by the Tokyo Immigration Bureau. After the school confirms the money transfer, the school will send the original copies of Certificate of Eligibility and Certificate of Admission to the applicant or his respective agent.</p> <p>Selection Fee, Admission Fee, Tuition Fee, Facility Maintenance Fee and Student Activity Fee are NOT refundable under any circumstances. However, if the applicant's application for the Student Visa is rejected by the respective Consulate Office of Japan and he cannot enter Japan as a result of that, the school will return the amount of money which is equivalent to 100% of Tuition Fee, Facility Maintenance Fee and Student Activity Fee to the applicant (please note: the money transfer fee and all the other fees which are charged by bank/s will be deducted from the money which is to be returned to the applicant).</p>
Visa Application Procedure	<p>The applicant is required to contact the respective Consulate Office of Japan and apply for the Student Visa at his own responsibility when he receives the original copies of his Certificate of Eligibility and Certificate of Admission.</p>
